Each eazitool is made from lightweight and rust-resistant aluminium and features a longer, double-cranked shaft, which gives greater leverage and reduces the need to bend. Blades are made from stainless steel, which is easier to clean and lighter to use than the traditional carbon steel, which soil tends to cling to.

Easy-to-hold soft-grip handles add comfort and act as shock absorbers, helping to prevent pain or injury when hitting hard objects in the ground. Each eazitool features a cast aluminium stirrup foot-hole with slip-resistant grippers – an innovative alternative to the traditional foot-bar design found on most forks and spades. The stirrup also helps to ensure equal weight distribution, centralising the downward pressure of the foot and minimising strain on the lower back.

Included in the range are a garden fork and spade, each costing £42.50, plus an edger and a weeder (both £32.50), making this the ideal multi-purpose garden tool set.

No more ants

The popular range of nematode pest controls from Nemasys has now added ants to its hit list. "Nemasys 'No Ants' has been undergoing consumer trials for two years, and the feedback has been so positive that we are now launching it to the whole market," says Graeme Gowling, general European manager of nemasysinfo.com

In the summer, black, red and yellow ants can be found in the garden as swarms of flying ants take to the air looking for a mate and a place to lay their eggs. The yellow meadow ant builds its nest in the lawn, making unsightly mounds. Red ants are aggressive and can deliver a painful sting if disturbed. Black ants are the ones most commonly seen in the house, attracted by sweet food. They 'farm' aphids for their honeydew, protecting them from predators and moving them to new feeding grounds if necessary. Black ants can nest anywhere, including under pavements and along the sides of lawns, with nests containing up to 7000 ants.

New 'No Ants' can be used any time between April and September. All you have to do is follow the simple mixing instructions and drench the nest with the nematodes. A standard pack, which will treat up to 16 nests, costs £10.75.

Avoid kitchen sink dramas

There's nothing quite like vegetables fresh from the garden – but they tend to come indoors complete with soil, outer leaves and the odd slug or two, all of which end up in the kitchen sink. What you need is the new Dossil Hexapus, which fits snugly over any plug hole and stops debris getting into the U-bend – so you won't have to reach for the plunger.

As water drains away, debris collects on the Dossil Hexapus, and can be easily removed from the sink. Made from durable silicone and available in three colours – yellow, white and aqua – it has suckers on its underside so that it sits securely over the plug hole. After use, you can stick it to the side of your sink so it is always to hand.

There's also the Original Dossil, available in five colours and two sizes – and both designs can also be used in baths and showers to help prevent the clogging caused by stray hairs and soap scum.
